



STUDENT CONDUCT:

The Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles Administrative Rules allow the DUI Program to

1. **DIS-ENROLL or REFUSE to ENROLL** any individual who
 - **Refuses** to complete the folder information, answer the testing instrument,
 - **Refuses** to actively participate in the evaluation appointment or the class sessions.
2. **DIS-ENROLL or REFUSE to ENROLL** any individual who is
 - **Disruptive** or
 - **Unwilling to Comply** with the rules and procedures of the Program.

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR is defined as using abusive, threatening language or gestures; shouting or using profanity at staff or at other students; or behavior which would be unacceptable in Court.

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR may result in a call to 911 for escort from the premises, and possibly a No Trespass Order. A report of the incident will be sent to the Court and /or Probation.

NO WEAPONS: In addition, no student will be allowed to bring any deadly or dangerous weapon to registration, class session or evaluation appointment. This includes guns, knives, scissors, box cutters or any other item that can be used as a weapon. Bringing such items to any DUI related function will result in immediate dismissal from the function, a call to 911 for escort from the premises, and may result in disenrollment from DUI School.

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION: I acknowledge that I must bring a **Photo ID** to class and will present that ID to the instructor when requested. I understand that failure to bring a Photo ID will result in dismissal from class and I will be charged a rescheduling fee.

These guidelines were established to provide all students with a positive and safe learning environment.

CLIENTS UNDER THE INFLUENCE

According to Administrative Rule 15A-10.021, the DUI School shall dismiss any student who is believed to have consumed alcohol or illegal drugs, or abused prescription drugs as evidenced by behavior, odor, or observation of consumption or student's admission of use.

The Florida Safety Council conducts random alcohol screenings.

All clients will be subject to random alcohol screening in any DUI class or evaluation. Clients with a positive alcohol screen will be asked to leave after securing alternative transportation. Clients who are asked to leave will be required to pay the full fee and begin the DUI process from the beginning. Clients who decline the alcohol screening will be assumed to be under the influence and asked to leave.

Clients on prescription medication who cannot participate fully in class or evaluation and exhibit symptoms consistent with alcohol or drug use will be asked to leave.

I have read and understand these rules. I understand that if I attend any part of DUI Program under the influence of drugs or alcohol, I will be dismissed and required to begin the DUI Program again and pay the full fee.

REASON FOR ENROLLING IN THE DUI COUNTERATTACK PROGRAM

PLEASE CHECK APPROPRIATE LEVEL – Based upon Lifetime history in All states / countries – not just Florida:

- DUI-Level I:** First arrest for DUI; NO prior DUI, DWI, DUI reduced to Reckless Driving, or First Suspension for driving with unlawful BAL or for Refusal in your lifetime \$245.00
- DUI-Level I:** Minor with a .02 citation (Florida Statute 322.2616) BAL .05 or higher or this is 2nd refusal \$245.00
- DUI-Level I:** Drug Charge under Chapter 893 with License Suspension \$245.00

- DUI Level II:** second or more arrest (s) for DUI, DWI, DUI reduced to reckless, or prior driving with unlawful BAL in your lifetime \$385.00
- DUI Level II:** previous attendance at any DUI Education Program or School, example – for a Drug Charge under Chapter 893 \$385.00
- DUI Level II:** attendance required by another state due to hour requirement \$385.00

Evaluation Only: Other than a Florida DUI offense; examples: -Illinois Report, SSS Program Appeal, etc. \$150.00

DUI Special Supervision Services: Monitoring program for Hardship license due to 5, 10 year or permanent revocation \$300.00

Note: if through a records check by the DUI program, by the Court, or by the Driver License Bureau, it is determined that you have had a prior DUI, DWI, OUI, OWI, DWAI, Reckless-Driving arrest- alcohol or drug related; or you have had a prior license suspension for alcohol or for refusal; or you have had a prior DUI program attendance anywhere, in your lifetime, on a Florida license or on any other state license, the money paid will be forfeited and you will be required to pay the fee for the appropriate class. Money paid and class time attended will not transfer / nor will it be credited. **The complete, official Lifetime Florida Driving Record will be processed by the Florida Safety Council at the time of enrollment.** If the MVR is supplied by the student, the Driving Record must be an official DHSMV-based printout, less than 15 days old, and reflect a lifetime record. If another state issued the Driver License, the lifetime record from that state will also need to be presented, and the record must be less than 30 days old.

REGISTRATION TAKES APPROXIMATELY TWO HOURS, SO PLEASE PLAN AHEAD

Tuition Fees effective October 1, 2011 **:

Level I: \$245.00 No Prior DUI or Reckless Arrest, Suspension or Revocation in Lifetime. - 12 Hours

Level II: \$385.00 Has any prior DUI or Reckless Arrest, Suspension, Revocation, or Level I class in Life. - 21 Hours and a Self Help Meeting

Fees are payable in cash, money order, or credit card. Official Lifetime Driving Record will be processed for a fee of \$14.00.

On-line Registrations will require a \$ 7.00 processing fee in addition to tuition.

Evaluations are provided in all office locations. Daytime and evening evaluation appointments are available.

Reassignment Fees **:

Table with 5 columns: Classes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd or Subsequent, After 90 days. Rows include Level I, Level II, Evaluations Level I, and Evaluations Level II.

Documentation required when enrolling in the DUI Program:

- 1. Driver License Number
2. Arrest Affidavit (Arrest Report or Traffic Crash Report) - must be a legible copy
3. Citation or Notice of Suspension - must be a legible copy
4. Results of Breath or Blood test, Urinalysis results, Refusal Slip
5. Court Disposition, Court Order, Pre-Trial Contract - (if have already appeared in Court)
6. Picture ID-- such as a current Florida Identification Card, US Passport.
7. Complete, official Lifetime Florida Driving Record

** Tuition Fees are approved and Reassignment Fees are set by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and include the \$15.00 DUI State Assessment Fee. Tuition Fees are subject to change at the direction of the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles. Tuition fee is valid for only 90 days from date of enrollment and is not refundable. After 90 days the full tuition is paid again and both evaluation and classes are started over again. Classes always start over with class session 1. If the student arrives at a class session or the evaluation appointment under the influence of alcohol or other drugs, the full fee will be paid again. If student's behavior is disruptive or threatening, he/she may be dis-enrolled. Tuition Fees are not refundable.

The complete, official Lifetime Florida Driving Record will be processed by the Florida Safety Council at the time of enrollment. If the MVR is supplied by the student, the Driving Record must be an official DHSMV-based printout, less than 15 days old for a Florida record and less than 30 days old for an out of state record, and reflect a lifetime record. If another state issued the Driver License, the lifetime record from that state will also need to be provided by the student.
